Internet Website Policy

The purpose of the Website is to promote the exchange of information among the Leaders, Scouts and Parents in Troop 167 of the Finger Lakes Council, and to enhance the mission to the community by promoting the program, aims and methods of the Boy Scouts of America.

Content:

All documents, illustrations, photographs and linked material must conform to the principles, policies and traditions of the Boy Scouts of America, the Finger Lakes Council and the unit's chartered partner.

Youth Protection:

Pictures of youth on the website *shall not* have their name or any other personal information associated with the picture.

Pictures of youth on the website *require* a release form signed by their parent or guardian.

Lists of youth achievements or awards in the website *shall not* have last names, last initials or any identifying information about youth members beyond a first name.

Under no circumstances shall the address, personal phone number or e-mail address of any youth be published on the Internet.

Adult Leadership:

Names and information about any adult shall be published *only* with the written approval of that individual.

A Troop 167 email address will be assigned to any adult leader requesting one, per Troop 167 email guidelines.
